

## **Dress for County Matches**

Dress for attending matches shall be an approved County shirt and grey trousers. The wearing of white shirt, Association tie and blazer is optional and where done so fully badged players may wear a green blazer which shall display the Association Badge whilst unbadged players may wear their Club blazer.

Dress for playing in matches shall be the approved County shirt and white trousers or BE approved shorts. If worn, pullovers, cardigans, belts and socks must be white, cream or approved County apparel. Braces if worn should not be visible and regulation bowling shoes shall be worn (no sandals).

In inclement weather white or approved County waterproofs may be worn.

No other Association or Club cloth badges will be displayed on a County Blazer/Jacket other than official county flashes which will be worn under the breast pocket. Flashes awarded by the pre-unification associations may still be worn, other than where they have been superseded by one introduced by the unified association. The County Association badge cannot be worn on any other than the County Green blazer.

If players are incorrectly dressed, they may not be permitted to play.
