

COUNTY MATCH SHIRTS – NEW DESIGN

The delegates will see that Gloucestershire is presented across the shoulders with the Gloucestershire flag, also known as the Severn Cross, placed above it.

The flag design was the winning entry in a competition held to commemorate the 1000th anniversary of the county in March 2008. It's coloured blue, cream and green, representing the River Severn, Cotswold stone and the Golden Valley, Stroud respectively.

The right sleeve has an image of the Plantagenet three lions in tribute to the original GBA badge.

Inside the collar it says 'Gloucestershire', on the back of the collar it says 'prorsum semper' which is the county council motto, taken from the county council coat of arms and means 'always forward'.

The men's team squads have all been asked, by the Team Manager, to purchase shorts/trousers which themselves have the badge and Gloucestershire written by the left pocket.

It is intended that the Men will wear them for the Middleton Cup, Balcombe and White Rose National Competitions in the 2022 season.

The timetable for the introduction of the new County Match Shirts for all County matches is a decision of the Joint Executive Council.
